Academic Achievement

Class X CBSE 2018 Result

42 students appeared for the examination in March, 2018. The school has emerged out triumphantly with cent percent pass out result .

Ananya S Ashok is the top scorer with 91 percent marks. Monisha Shil has scored 90.4 percent and Shashank Dasari has added splendour with his score of 90.2 percent.

The overall class average is 78 percent.62 percent of the students have secured above 80 percent aggregate marks.

Class XII CBSE 2018 Result

Class XII students put up an excellent result at the All India Senior Secondary Examination -2018. The school is proud to have cent percent result with fifty percent of the students scoring distinction and the rest of them with first class aggregate marks.
