I would like to present the glimpses of the major mile stones of the academic year 2018 – 19- from mid November 2018 till date.

### Academic Achievement

- **CBSE 2019 Class X Result**

65 students appeared for the examination and we achieved cent percent result.

17 students have scored above 90 percent marks while 33 students have scored distinction marks in class 10. The top scorers are Anna Douglas with 97.4 %, Gautham Krishna with 96.8 % and Syeda Sara with 96 % aggregate score.

- **CBSE 2019 Class XII Result :**

30 students appeared for the examination and the school is proud to have achieved cent percent result.

In class XII , 5 students have scored above 90 percent marks and 17 of them have scored distinction marks. The top scorers are Karen Romany with 94.6 %, Sandra Mathew with 94.4 % and Amal Sajan with 92 % marks.

- Orientation Programme for the parents was held and the curriculum plans were conveyed Guidelines were given the parents on their role in the curriculum transaction
- Parent Teacher meet was conducted on 1<sup>st</sup> Oct, 9<sup>th</sup> Oct and 10<sup>th</sup> Oct on 7<sup>th</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> and result of the first term examination was given.
- Special classes are held for classes IX to XII on every Saturday.
- Art, music, dance, sports, reading activities , project work, group activities and field trips are integrated in the process of learning.
