INTRODUCTION

Indian school Sur was established in 1989 to serve the educational needs of the children of the expatriate Indian community. The school is an English medium co-educational school and is affiliated to CBSE New Delhi (India). The School Management Committee (SMC) works under the guidance of the Board of Directors for Indian schools in the Sultanate of Oman. The sub-committee for school administration consists of the President, Convener, Treasurer and other members, selected by the Board of Directors for Indian schools in Oman. The school is functioning in a building with very spacious and airy class rooms. The school library provides books and reading materials to cater to the needs of the students. In addition to the well equipped laboratories for Science, Mathematics and Computer Science, the school is equipped with audio-visual labs.

ADMISSION

Admission is available for both boys and girls of Indian origin with Indian passports. Admission is also available for other nationals, provided they fulfil all the requirements specified by the school.

Age Criteria : (on or before 31st of March of the current year)

LKG : 3 years
UKG: 4 years
Class I : 5 years

Note : A corresponding age limit is applicable for the successive classes.

OTHER NATIONALS

The application forms submitted by the other nationals will have to be approved by the Embassy of India (Muscat). Along with the application, a letter of introduction by an Indian citizen stating that he knows the applicant, a copy of his/her identity card and passport should be enclosed.

REGISTRATION

Admission to any class is possible only, after registration at the school office. The parents can obtain the application form from the school office.

ENTRY LEVEL ASSESSMENT

Non Indian applicants will have to appear for a written test before admission. However there is no written test /interview for admission in LKG. General ability of the child will be assessed in an interview, before admission.

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED

1. Birth certificate/a copy of the Passport(for age proof)
2. School leaving /Transfer Certificate duly attested.
3. Progress Report of the previous year.
4. Two passport size photographs each of the applicant and the parents.
5. Passport, visa& resident card copies of the child and parents
6. Copy of recently paid electricity bill.
7. NOC from the concerned Embassy (for non-Indians)

SCHOOL FEE

Fee payment slip is given out in the beginning of every month. Fee should be paid before the end of every month. Late fee will be charged after the due date

EXAMINATION

All the examinations are conducted as per the rules and regulations framed by the CBSE.
