ONLINE VIRTUAL CLASSES ON ZOOM PLATFORM








As per the Ministerial Decision, on 14th March, the closed school was precautionary measure to stay safe from the pandemic- Covid-19. On March 15th a meeting was held by the Principal for the teachers to formulate a new teaching plan for the students of classes X and XII. The school began the online virtual classes in mid-March for Classes X and XII. On March 21st a message from the Ambassador of India was circulated to the parents requesting the precautions to be taken on the wake of Covid-19. Videos of innovative, simple easy and interesting lessons and activities to engage the children

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in an active way at home were sent . School began online classes for all other classes in the beginning of April compliance with the directives of the Ministry of Education of the Sultanate and the Central Board for Secondary Education, to upkeep the student learning process during the suspension period and thereby ensuring continued learning regardless of the adverse circumstances. By the end of March 2020 online class coordinators were appointed for all classes. Class Time Table was given to all the classes. From April first week children geared themselves up explore the tremendous to



possibilities of learning away from the classroom atmosphere equipping themselves with the upcoming developments in the world strictly adhering to the norms of the online platform. Covid- 19 took away all the fun we had in school, still we reconnected in virtual platform and classes were resumed. Initially Zoom was the platform to connect and reflect. Zoom witnessed PTMs. sessions exams and webinars. Gradually the online classes were shifted to the Google platform. From August, classes V to XII are attending the sessions on Google Meet.



Fee Concession for all the Students

Considering the financial constraints faced by parents ,as per the direction of the Board of Directors of Indian Schools in Oman the school gave a circular informing that only tuition fee would be charged during the pandemic phase till August. It was detailed in the circular signed by the SMC President that fee hike for the academic year 2020-21 would be waived till July 2020. Transport fee would not be charged from April till school resumes regular functioning. Late fee also would not be charged from April 2020 to August 2020. It was intimated that in addition to the concessions announced by the BoD , the School Management Committee would further reduce

25% of tuition fee for the period of 4 months from May to August 2020. Parents were requested to pay only 75% of tuition fees. It was also informed that 50% concession on the tuition fee would be given till the end of the academic term 2020-21 to the student, if the parent or student contract the SARS CoV-2 infection and become covid positive during this academic year. Parents were advised to pay the fee either by using Bank Muscat Mobile App or through CDM facility and send the details to accounts@indianschoolsur.com and for further queries to principal@indianschoolsur.com / info@indianschoolsur.com

Health and Fitness Video instructions:



To keep the students healthy and fit during the lock down days, the Physical Education department created special video lessons

These videos were circulated to all the students of our school on regular intervals that motivated many students and parents to perform exercise every day. 

Under the aegis of the Embassy of India in the Sultanate, the Board of Directors has been guiding us to participate in a number of webinar sessions and teacher training programmes to provide motivation and guidance to the teachers on making the virtual teaching more effective. A webinar organized exclusively for the teachers in the Indian Schools in Oman, where an interactive session was held with the CBSE examination controller gave a deep insight into the innovations that CBSE is going to introduce on the various aspects of Board examinations.

EVALUATIONS

The school administration and teachers adapted themselves overnight to start the online classes. Thus the students began the online journey from the month of April. One of the major challenges we have been facing in the online – virtual teaching is evaluations.

We have been striving to adapt ourselves to the challenges in our own way to ensure that there is no gap in the education of students.

Within a month of starting the online classes came the next challenge in front of us – How to assess the learning of the students? The answer for this was online assessments.

The planning and implementation resulted in three **Periodic Assessments (June, July & August)** and

the First Term Examination for classes III to XII from mid - September.

Classes I & II also had two Periodic Assessments and the First Term Examination as well.

Special plan for the Board Exam Classes

Sensing the need for one step further preparation required for the students who are going to appear for the CBSE Board examinations this academic year we have started written examinations where the students are expected to write descriptive answers to the Board pattern questions given, and upload the answer sheets.

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WE SHINE IN CLASS X CBSE RESULT

The results for class X CBSE board exams were declared by CBSE, New Delhi on 15 July and everyone was excited at Indian School Sur.

The school has been very consistent in securing brilliant results and this year they have excelled with high percentages. Miss Khazeena Eman topped with 486 marks (97.2 %) followed by Miss Jouvana Romany Rashid with 477 marks (95.4%) and Miss Bushra Binth Shahin with 471 marks (94.2%).

WE SECURE 100% RESULT IN CBSE CLASS XII

The results for class XII CBSE board exams were declared on 13th July by CBSE New Delhi. The school has achieved 100% results. Everyone in the school is hilariously happy and excited about the excellent results.

In the Science stream, Miss Fathima Thahsin topped the school with 473 marks (94.6 %) followed by Miss Ananya Ashok with 451 marks (90.2 %) and Miss Anzlah Khalid with 450 marks (90.0 %). Out of 24 students who appeared for the class XII exam, 19 got Distinction i.e above 75% and 5 students between 64% and 74%.




