Student Awards and Recognition Framework for the Academic Year 2025–26

Greetings from Indian School Sur!

We are pleased to inform you that our school will continue to recognize and reward outstanding student achievements through a well-defined Awards and Recognition Framework for the academic year 2025–26. These awards aim to encourage excellence across academics, co-curricular activities, sports, leadership, and service to the school community.

Below is an overview of the various awards and their key selection criteria:

1. ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE AWARDS

1.1 Classes III to IX & XI

Selection Criteria:

- Performance in all examinations conducted during the academic year 2025-26 will be considered.
- Only overall toppers from each class (combining all sections A, B, C, etc.) will be eligible.
- Students must achieve A1 grades in all subjects.
- Students appearing for improvement examinations will not be considered.

1.2 Classes X & XII

Selection Criteria:

- School toppers securing 1st, 2nd, and 3rd positions in Board Examinations will be awarded.
- Subject toppers in Class 10 & 12 Board Examinations will be awarded.
- Students must achieve A1 grades in all subjects.
- Students appearing for improvement examinations will not be considered.

2. ACADEMIC PROFICIENCY AWARD

Selection Criteria:

- This award recognizes all students who achieve **A1 grade** in all subjects in the final examination
- Applicable for Classes 3 to 9 & 11
- Students must have appeared for all examinations conducted during the academic year without any absence
- Students appearing for improvement examinations will not be considered

- This award acknowledges consistent academic excellence throughout the year culminating in outstanding final examination performance
- Recipients will receive a certificate of achievement and recognition during the Annual Award Ceremony

3. CO-CURRICULAR EXCELLENCE AWARDS

Selection Criteria:

- Points earned through participation in Co-curricular Activities (CCA) and Sports events.
- Points scored in inter-school competitions will be given additional weightage.
- Consistent participation and excellence across multiple domains will be considered.
- Special recognition for outstanding achievements at national levels.

4. STUDENT OF THE YEAR AWARD

Selection Criteria:

- Academic performance across Classes X, XI, and XII will be evaluated
- Participation and achievements in Sports, Games, and CCA in Classes X, XI, and XII.
- Special weightage for exemplary performance in National & International events.
- Service to school and community engagement will be recognized.
- Leadership roles as School Office Bearers will be considered.

Weightage Distribution:

- Academics: 60%
- CCA & Games/Sports: 35%
- Leadership positions (School/House Office Bearers): 5%

Points for Leadership Positions:

• Leadership positions (Student council and house office bearers position in classes X, XI & XII.): 2 Marks for each position

5. BEST ATHLETE AWARD

Selection Criteria:

Total Points Calculation:

• Cumulative points earned in the current academic year from Annual Athletic Meet, Inter-House, Cluster, and National events.

CBSE Oman Cluster Competitions:

- The highest individual performance in each competition will be considered.
- Points allocation: Gold (7 points), Silver (5 points), Bronze (3 points).
- All individual athletic events and relay performances will be counted.

Annual Athletic Meet Performance:

- Individual performance in each event
- Points allocation: Gold (7 points), Silver (5 points), Bronze (3 points)

Additional Guidelines:

- Maximum points in a particular game: 7 points
- Participation points: 1 point for each event (Annual Athletic Meet, Inter-House, Cluster, and National events)
- The athlete with the highest total score will be awarded the Best Athlete Award

General Guidelines

Students must have a minimum of 90% attendance and a clean disciplinary record to be eligible for any award.

All recognition will be presented during the Award ceremony/major functions of the school.

The selection process is based on verified records and will be overseen by an Award Committee comprising staff and management representatives to ensure transparency.

We encourage all students to actively participate in all areas of school life and strive for excellence. These awards not only recognize academic and co-curricular achievements but also foster values of leadership, sportsmanship, and holistic development.
